Arden Park Explorers Summer Camp 2025

Description: Arden Park Recreation and Park District is piloting our first Junior Leader program for the Arden Park Explorers Summer Camp. We are looking for youth 12-15 years old that have an interest in leadership development, teamwork, and that want to have fun while working with children ages 5-11 during the summer in a volunteer capacity. Junior Leaders in the Arden Park Explorers Summer Camp and Crest Critters Summer Camp programs will be mentored by camp staff and they will gain confidence, create lasting friendships, and build skills to become future Recreation Leaders at summer camp. Mandatory Staff Training will be held on Thursday 6/12. Summer Camp runs June 16-August 8, 2025.

<u>Requirements</u>: Must be 12-15 years old. No previous experience is required, however babysitting, volunteer work, or having attended summer camp previously is a plus. Application must be submitted by **Friday, April 12th**. If selected for an interview, the Recreation Supervisor will reach out directly to you. Applicants <u>must</u> fill out this application by themselves.

Disclaimer and Signature: Potential Junior Leaders must complete this application themselves and submit by Friday, April 11th to be considered for this position. From there, we will reach out to set up an interview. Mandatory Staff Training will be held on Thursday 6/12. Summer Camp runs June 16-August 8, 2025. If offered a position, Junior Leaders will be assigned a shift, as stated above. Shifts are either AM or PM. Junior Leaders may not arrive before their scheduled time, and may not stay later than their scheduled time, unless otherwise approved by the Recreation Supervisor. Staff meetings will be every other week during Friday lunch for the Junior Leaders and will be 30 minutes long. We will also host team bonding activities during the summer. Your position as a Junior Leaders is dependent upon your work performance. If there are continual issues with work performance, you may be dismissed as a Junior Leader for the summer. Junior Leaders are technically considered participants and are covered under our program waiver. They are not considered official recreation staff.
